



Match Guidelines

All Government guidelines on social distancing to be observed

Changing Rooms:	Cannot be used. Players to turn up ready changed or change in car
Registering:	All players, guests and visitors are required to register contact details for tracing purposes. This can preferably be done online before the game via the website
Sanitising:	Hand sanitiser is available at the club but it is recommended that players have their own as well
Clubhouse:	Limited access to the club house to be available for toilets.
Players Equipment:	Should not be shared. If it is necessary then it must be cleaned before and after use.
Bar:	Outside bar facilities to be available, compliant with the current licensing regulations
Payments:	All payments to be made by card or contactless
Furniture:	Tables and chairs to be set up outside the clubhouse and cleaned before and after use.
Scorebox:	The current directive is that scoreboxes should not be used. We have a portable scoreboard that can be used. The passing of the scorebook should be avoided.
Teas:	The initial guidelines do not permit the provision of teas as we would normally expect. Players and guests must bring their own food and drink.
Umpiring:	The communal use of umpire's coats will not be permitted. Umpires are not to handle the ball or any players clothing or equipment
Running Lines:	Batsmen running between the wickets must social distance by the non striker standing and running outside the new 'running lines' marked on adjacent strips.
Health Breaks:	To be taken every 6 overs in order to sanitise hands and clean the ball (responsibility of fielding captain)
